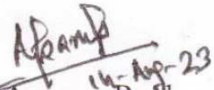

INTRODUCTION

Project appraisal is the systematic process by which a financial institution makes an independent and objective assessment of the various aspects of the investment proposition for arriving at a financing decision. Project appraisal consists of financial analysis, risk assessment, feasibility analysis and cost benefits analysis of various aspects of a proposed project to adjudge its viability.

Financial institutions appraise a project considering the technical, financial, economic and regulatory & legal considerations. Technical feasibility refers to evaluating and assessing the associated technologies in the proposed project to build a final framework within the prescribed norms. The project appraisal under financial analysis involves evaluating the financial viability, revenue projections, cost estimation, cash flow analysis and financial sustainability over its life cycle. The spirit of due diligence of the appraisal lies in identifying techno, commercial, regulatory aspects of the projects and factoring the same in appraisal process. Social cost benefit analysis involves project's social and community impacts. This analysis assess the project's effects on employment, public services and overall welfare.

Loan Documentation is a collection of legal and financial documents required to complete the lending process and establish a Common Loan Agreement (CLA) between a Lender and the Borrower. It consists of specific conditions, precedents, affirmative covenants, negative covenants, events of defaults, indemnities etc. The remedial actions in any event of default or dispute will be based on loan documents executed.

The loan disbursement process will commence only upon compliance of stipulated pre-commitment and pre-disbursement conditions. Loan documentation primarily consists of loan agreement, security agreement, corporate/personal guarantee, insurance policies, regulatory documents, financial statements, etc. Though the loan documentation process is similar for all types of loans, the documents will differ from lender to lender and the nature of the loan.

INTRODUCTION

In the process of augmenting distribution infrastructure for reliable and affordable power to all, many policies were launched for the distribution sector, such as DDUGJY and UDAY primarily focused on the financial turnaround of the DISCOMs.

The Government of India launched a reform policy for the Distribution sector in July 2021 named as Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme (RDSS) meant to be a facilitator to improve the operational efficiencies of Discoms and help to reduce their losses and make them financially sustainable. The scheme aims to reduce AT&C losses to pan-India levels of 12-15 percent by 2024-25 and cut the cost-revenue gap to zero by 2024-25. Besides its focus on augmenting distribution infrastructure, the policy aims to achieve technological advancement in the energy landscape towards its journey to ensure 24X7 reliable, sustainable and affordable power.

A key component and parameter of the scheme's success would be adoption and implementation of smart metering technology. The Centre has set an ambitious target of installing 250 million smart meters by 2025. The metering industry has taken rapid strides in recent years by traversing from automated meter reading (AMR) to smart metering.

The significant implications of Smart metering are Energy Efficiency and Conservation, Demand side Management, empowering consumers with data, Remote monitoring and management and impact on environment and sustainability.

The procedure requires purchase requisition, preparation of the tender document, floating of tender following all norms, evaluation of document, awarding the tender to L1 Vendor, Agreement and execution of the contract. Therefore, it is important for REC Employees involved in the procurement process to update themselves on the purchase procedure, including e-tendering, Reverse Auction and especially on purchase through the GEM portal.

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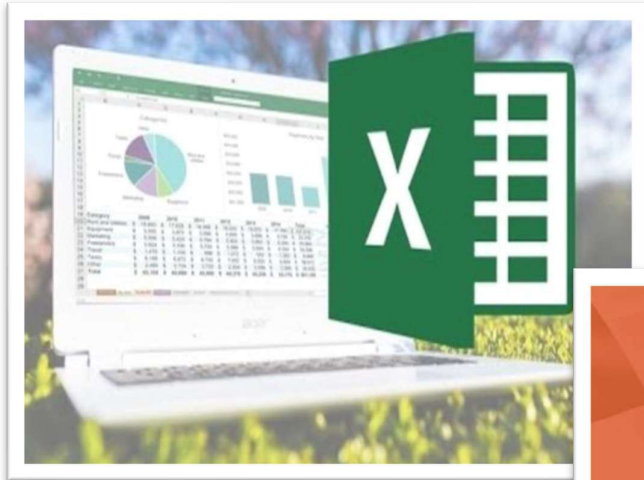
